SCHOOL BUS RULES

School buses are extensions of the school, and the same rules and expected behavior apply while riding. The following bus rules are for the safety of all passengers, and to help ensure the driver can concentrate on his or her responsibilities.

- ✓ Follow directions given by your Bus Driver and Bus Attendant.
- ✓ Use quiet voices: No yelling or screaming.
- ✓ Must always be quiet at all railroad crossings.
- ✓ **Profanity and inappropriate gestures or threats** will not be tolerated.
- ✓ Instigating or bullying will also not be tolerated.
- ✓ Stay in your seat at all times, no standing or switching seats unless you're instructed.
- ✓ Keep aisle way clear at all times.
- ✓ Do not throw objects inside or out of the bus.
- ✓ No horseplay or fighting and no weapons are permitted.
- ✓ Flashlights or laser pointers are not permitted.
- ✓ No eating or drinking on the bus choking hazard.
- ✓ Enter and Exit the bus in a **single file line** no pushing or shoving.
- ✓ Keep all body parts inside the bus at all times. No screaming or hanging out of the windows.
- ✓ No playing music.
- ✓ Cell phones should be put away wile on the bus. Personal electronic device recording is not allowed on the bus at any time.
- ✓ **Destruction of property** (including the bus and seats) is strictly prohibited, and parents can be held responsible for the cost of repairs.
- ✓ Personal belongings should always be put away and kept safe.
- ✓ Be respectful of one another.

Camera Notice: For the safety of our passengers, all buses are equipped with a camera system that continuously records the video and audio of all activities on the bus.

If these rules are not followed, a student will be subject to bus conduct write ups, and continued discipline problems can lead to suspension from all buses for a period of time based on school/Trinity policy. Safety is the most important priority and following these rules help keep all students safe while on the school bus.

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
